SecureCorps, An AmeriCorps Program

SecureCorps is an AmeriCorps program for persons over 18 years old who have completed high school, to serve York County by:

Assisting non-profits and businesses in developing plans for coping with a disaster (May–August)

Providing disaster readiness training and education to children and adults (May–August)

Promoting wellness activities (May–August)

Serving as IRS certified tax preparers to assist low income residents and the elderly by providing free tax preparation (November–May)
